## **The Small Business Construction-Tax Suspension Incentive Program**

*San José, CA* – The Small Business Construction-Tax Suspension Incentive Program offers small companies with 35 or fewer employees an opportunity to lower development costs when they improve or expand their space by May 19, 2006. As part of the City of San Jose’s continuing efforts to support the expansion of businesses, the Program is designed to encourage small business growth by reducing the taxes required for tenant improvements. The temporary program reduces construction costs for small businesses by suspending 50% of the construction taxes typically charged on these projects for the first 3,000 square feet developed.
